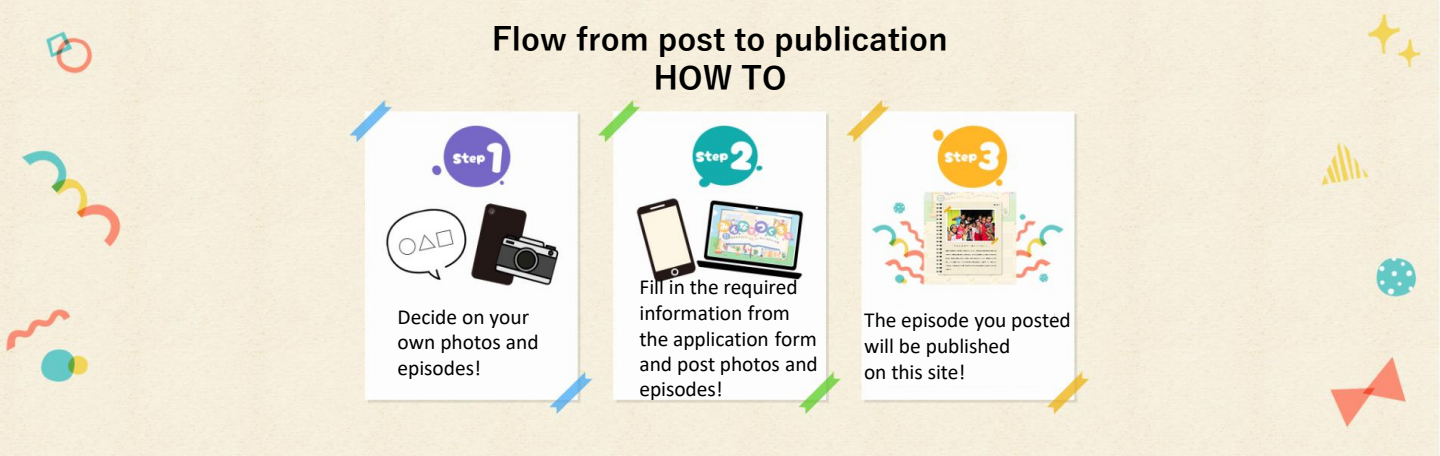

Submission Guidelines

◆ Handling of Personal Information

(1)
Any personal information submitted will be strictly managed and will not be disclosed, transferred, or lent to any third party without legitimate reason. The use of personal information will be limited solely to notifying individuals who are selected as award recipients or whose works are chosen for exhibition in this project.
However, this excludes cases in which certain tasks related to the exhibition are outsourced to a third party that has entered into a confidentiality agreement with the Ministry of Justice.

The dedicated submission website will be closed after the submission deadline. All submitted data will be deleted from the system upon closure of the site.

◆ Important Notes

Please submit your work in JPG or PNG format.
Submissions must be unpublished works created by the applicant personally.
Works generated by AI will not be accepted.
Only individual submissions are allowed.
Submissions must be made under a pen name (real names or organization names are not permitted).
Entries containing incomplete or false information may be disqualified.
Multiple submissions are allowed; however, each applicant can receive only one award.
Once submitted, titles, comments, and submitter information cannot be modified or corrected, nor can the submitted image be replaced.
You may submit multiple works, but the same work cannot be submitted more than once. Please review your submission carefully before uploading.
The submitter is responsible for obtaining permission from any individuals appearing in the photographs (portrait rights).
The copyright of the submitted works belongs to the photographer, while the right of use belongs to the Ministry of Justice.
Submitted works may be used for secondary purposes such as exhibitions other than the All Together Festival (including loaned displays to other organizations), publication on the Ministry of Justice website, and other media for publicity purposes.
When the Ministry of Justice uses award-winning works for such secondary purposes, necessary modifications or edits may be made.

◆ Additional Notes

Due to limited exhibition space, not all submitted works may be displayed at the venue. However, all submitted photographs will be available for viewing on the official website.

Submissions must not violate public order or morality. The All Together Festival Secretariat reserves the right to reject any work deemed inappropriate or inconsistent with the purpose of this project.

When works are exhibited or published, the pen name and title of the work will be made public.
